Marina Oswald is mentioned in an Army file on Michael R. Paine. Richard Davis is mentioned in Army files on Charles A. Scott and Karl A. Zeiger. Carlos Sanchez is mentioned in Army files on Joaquin Balaguer, David Siqueirof, Viacente Lambardo, Luis M. Bulnes, Menendez Manuel W. Marti, Victor Espinosa, Leo Vigildo, R. Penafajardo and Jose Ramon.

Dear Andy Purdy,

As per our conversation, here belatedly is a copy of the draft memo (I never had time to polish it) I wrote on Marina and Lee. For the reasons I gave you, I ~~hope~~ trust you will see that it is tightly held within the Committee staff. I leave you to judge whether Prof. Blakey would like to read the whole memo, or perhaps just the first part ending on p. 12.

I also trust you have seen the two recent FBI releases of memos concerning Lt. Colonel Robert E. Jones of 112th Army Intelligence Group, San Antonio. I wish to join those who must by now have advised the Committee he should clearly be a witness and could give important information -- such as his source for his remarkably early knowledge of the Hidell card. Please note that his info about Marina's identification of the rifle gibes closely with that "translated" (and quite probably fabricated) by Marina's first interpreter, supplied via Army Intelligence Reserve: cf. my ms "Government Documents and the John F. Kennedy Assassination," which I sent you a year ago.

Also, I now have two widely separated sources (one of them ~~unusually~~ very credible) which indicate that the 1963 Artime-AM/LASH (Cubela) anti-Castro operation was being run by ~~support~~ CIA with support from European intelligence/paramilitary services. If you agree with me as to the importance of this possibility, I would be glad to supply you with the sources.

A final book-keeping matter. I am belatedly submitting my incidental expenses claim of \$27.00 re the conference (my per diem has already been paid). And I have not yet seen a cheque for \$21.00 to pay for the seven copies of Crime and Cover-Up which Jackie Hess ordered from me at the conference.
